WHAT IS TNR?

TNR stands for Trap-Neuter-Return. It's the most humane and effective approach to controlling the population of outdoor stray, feral, and community cats.

WHAT TNR DOES:

- Ensures no new kittens are born
- Improves the lives of outdoor cats
- Gives unadoptable cats the chance to live safely in their colonies

THE PROCESS:

- Cats are trapped in humane live traps
- They are spayed/neutered, vaccinated, and ear tipped (a small portion of one ear is surgically removed to identify the cat as spayed or neutered, it's painless and done under anesthesia)

- Cats recover indoors for 24-48 hours post surgery
- They are returned to the exact location they were trapped, where caretakers continue to provide food, water, and shelter

THE BIGGER PICTURE:

- 70 million homeless cats in the United States
- 480 million homeless cats worldwide
